

## Instructions for setting up your account.

You will need an internet connection: direct, or Wi-Fi.

On a computer, go to *Ontario Community Library Website*, hover the curser over "Services" to open the drop box.

Click on "Resource Links". Now click on "General".

Look in the alphabetical list for "Mango Language" and click on it.

A new window should open, it should say *Mango* at the top of the page and have a Log-in Box. It will have *Ontario Library District* at the top of the box like it is pictured here .

Next go down to the bottom of the form and click on "Sign up".

It is going to ask you to Create Your Profile.

Use the email address that is *associated with your Library Card*. Your Library account should be current with no fines or fees.

Create a password. This needs to be 8 digits and can contain numbers and letters.

Next you will be prompted to read and accept the <u>Data Consent Form</u>. Scroll to the bottom of the page and click on "I accept", after reading the appropriate information.

Your Mango Account should now open and ask you to <u>Pick a Language</u>. There over 70 world languages and dialects to choose from, including American Sign Language. After choosing a Language you will be able to start the learning process.

If you want to log out, change your profile, add a family member, or change the language you are learning go up to the right-hand corner and click on the 3 bars next to your email. And follow the prompts.

## Mobile Access (iOS/Android compatibility)

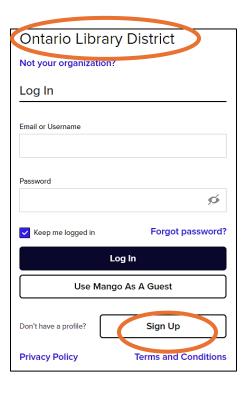
If you will be using a phone or tablet, you will now need to download the app to access your account.

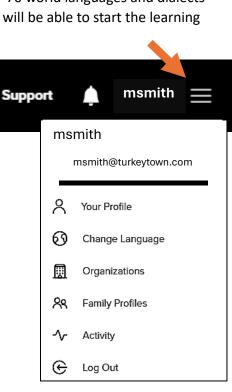
Go to your device's Play (app) Store and find the *Mango Language App*.
